Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Registered Designs (Border Enforcement Measures — Fees) Rules 2022 and come into operation on 21 November 2022.

Fees

2. The fees specified in the second column of the Schedule are payable to the Director-General in respect of the matters set out in the first column of that Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

1. For the processing of a written notice mentioned in section 68D(1) of the Act	\$200
2. For the escort of a conveyance conveying seized goods	\$20 per half hour (or part of a half hour) of a continuous operation
3. For the attendance of an authorised officer or a senior authorised officer in connection with —	
(a) the inspection of seized goods	\$20 per half hour (or part of a half hour) of a continuous operation
(b) the destruction of seized goods	\$40 per half hour (or part of a half hour) of a continuous operation
4. For the attendance of an authorised officer or a senior authorised officer in connection with any other act or service under Part 6A of the Act	\$20 per half hour (or part of a half hour) of a continuous operation
